# Scottsdale firm to co-develop Ritz-Carlton near Tucson

**By Diana Balazs** THE ARIZONA REPUBLIC

A Scottsdale-based company is codeveloping a \$500 million Ritz-Carlton project northwest of Tucson that will be the largest and most comprehensive Ritz-Carlton of its kind in the spokeswoman. United States.

Tim and Casey Bolinger of Greenbrier Southwest Corp. are collaborating with Cottonwood Properties of Tucson and the Ritz-Carlton Hotel Co. LLC to build the project on 850 acres within the 6,200-acre Dove Mountain master-planned community near the Tortolita Mountains.

Construction is under way. The re-

sort hotel is set to open in the fall of 2009.

It will be the second Ritz-Carlton property in Arizona. The first, the Ritz-Carlton Phoenix, 2401 E. Camelback Road, opened in the late 1980s, said Vivian Deuschl, Ritz-Carlton

Deuschl said the Ritz-Carlton Dove Mountain project will be the largest in the United States.

"We have other resorts that have combinations of residential, spa and golf but nothing of this magnitude in terms of size," she said.

Deuschl said Ritz-Carlton guests
